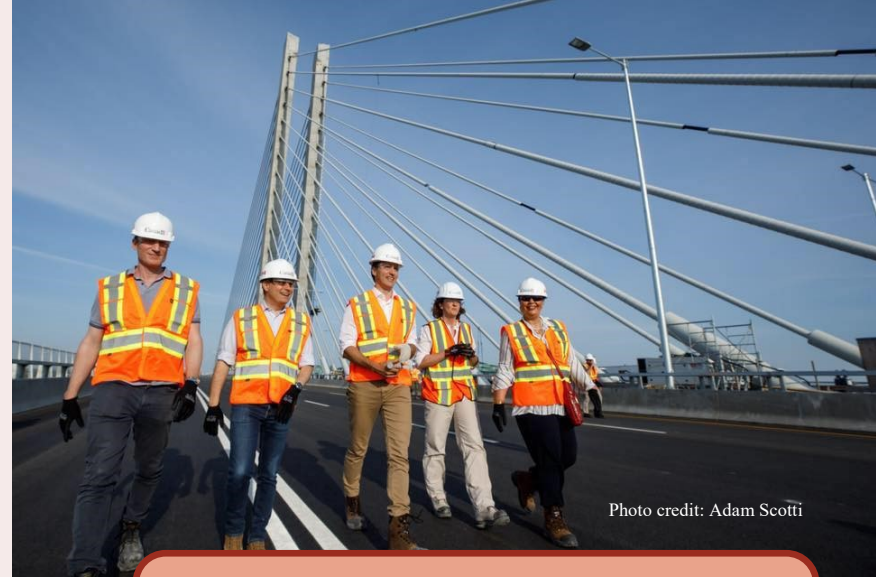

Fun Facts

- ⇒ The Samuel De Champlain Bridge opened to traffic on June 24th, 2019.
- ⇒ The New Champlain Bridge Corridor Project is one of the largest infrastructure projects in North America.
- ⇒ The Samuel De Champlain Bridge will be 3.4 kilometers long and consists of two traffic corridors with three lanes in each direction, a central corridor dedicated to public transit—the future Réseau express métropolitain train—and a multi-use path for cyclists and pedestrians.

Annual figures about the bridge

- * Approximately 50 million crossings
- * International trade valued at \$20 billion
- * 11 million public transit users

- Helping low-income seniors keep more of what they earn by enhancing the Guaranteed Income Supplement earnings exemption.

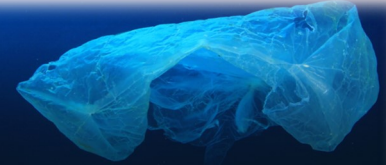
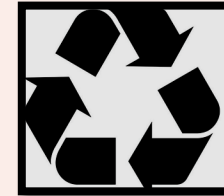
